### **Leggett to Host Town Hall Meeting in Wheaton-Kensington Area**

Montgomery County Executive Isiah Leggett will host a Town Hall Meeting in the Wheaton-Kensington area on Wednesday, March 23 at 7:30 p.m. at Crossway Community, 3015 Upton Drive. Previous town meetings have drawn thousands of residents who have taken advantage of the opportunity to voice their concerns to the County Executive.
